Here are some **important things** you probably already know, but I'll go over again just in case. In order to make a skydive, you must be at least 18 years old and weigh 220 lbs. or less. Height restrictions may also apply. After picking a date and time for a jump, you can schedule by calling 785.840.JUMP!

You need to **schedule** at least 48 hours in advance in order to receive the scheduling discount, and depending on the time of year, you may need to schedule even further in advance. During June, July, August, September, we sometimes fill up slots as much as a week and a half to two weeks in advance.

Plan on spending at least 4 hours for the whole experience unless you have a large group and you'll have to plan for more. You can save some time at the dropzone by having the paperwork already completed; you can also preview the tandem video (part of your training) at our online tandem class. www.skydivekansas.com/tandemclass If you don't get this paperwork finished, we have it at the dropzone waiting for you. Even if you preview this video, you will still watch it at the dropzone when you arrive.

Be sure to bring a driver's license or other form of photo ID with a birthdate on it. See **prices and discounts** on our website: www.skydivekansas.com/discounts We take MasterCard, Visa, American Express and Discover. We also welcome cashier's checks, money orders or cash. We also accept personal checks by ACH deposit (meaning you don't have to write a check, we just submit your checking account info.)


You can reserve a photographer for a DVD **video & still photographs package**. If you did not reserve a photographer, one may still be available at the dropzone the day of your jump; just ask and we will accommodate you if we are able. We also have T-shirts, long sleeve shirts, and other miscellaneous merchandise & souvenirs.

Dress for whatever you are comfortable in while being outside... If it's a bit cool out, don't wear something bulky and heavy, dress in layers. If it's warm out, remember don't wear sandals or boots; tennis shoes are best. We provide a jumpsuit, gloves, goggles, leather hat if desired. It is usually about 30 degrees cooler at altitude (but you aren't up there that long either). Our planes are heated and our student room is heated, a small pilot lounge is air conditioned. Remember you are outdoors. We have a pop machine and candy bars, chips, snacks and water for sale. Sonic, Pizza Hut, Subway, and a few local restaurants are located in town which is only a mile or so from the airport. This may seem obvious, but I'll say it anyway: you will not be allowed to skydive if you are under the influence or have used alcohol or recreational drugs within 12 hours of your skydive.
